**The spiel:** This mineral illuminating powder with a built-in contour brush can be used on the face to subtly brighten skin, or as a finishing powder.  
**The verdict:** I applied this powder over my cheeks, which worked great in winter to give me glowing skin without that full-on bronzer look.

**The spiel:** The ultra-fine micro powder in this foundation adjusts light to create the appearance of flawless, glowing skin.  
**The verdict:** I really liked that this lightweight foundation blended easily over my skin and gave a nice glow – much more so than the foundation I usually use.

**The spiel:** Blend this sheer luminiser sparingly over the cheek and brow bones to enhance the face without appearing greasy or glittery.  
**The verdict:** I spread this beautiful icy colour on top of my eye make-up, which looked especially glam when it caught the light at night.

**The spiel:** Brush on this formula (that contains light reflecting particles) either under make-up to conceal imperfections or over foundation for a burst of youthful radiance.  
**The verdict:** I used this under my eyes instead of concealer to mask dark spots and it made the area look lighter.

**The spiel:** Oil-free and non-greasy, smooth this creamy multi-purpose stick across cheeks, eyes, lips or décolletage to highlight and add shimmer.  
**The verdict:** I blended this creamy pinky stick around my eyes and the result was noticeable – it gave extra light and a pretty lift to tired eyes.

## the treatment: SMOOTHSHAPES

**what** A non-invasive cellulite treatment for lumps and bumps. Combining massage with laser and light energy and vacuum, a recommended eight sessions should see massive improvements!

**who** Oprah has raved about this machine on her show, as have the ladies of *The View*. Our editor Claire headed off to try it out...

**our experience** 'After talking about the treatment and looking at my "problem areas", I headed into the room. My practitioner, Ian, gave me some glasses to protect my eyes from the laser, and a gown to wear. Laying down on the bed I rested while a machine, that looks like a handheld vacuum cleaner, is slowly rolled up and around the treatment area, over and

over for 10 minutes at a time. The feeling is warm with some slight pulling of the skin as the vacuum goes over certain areas, but it's fairly soothing and comfortable. After 40 minutes I'm kneaded and done, and can already see – and feel – a slight improvement in the texture of my skin. Next step is to drink a lot of water to flush out the toxins that have been released into my system. They recommend three litres per day – which will certainly help!

**the verdict** 'While you don't see a vast immediate improvement after the first session, after a few more sessions I could definitely see that it worked. My skin was smoother and cellulite less visible – hurrah!'

**where** Claire tried it at Meei Clinic in Sydney's Double Bay, (02) 9362 2900, the only place in Australia to offer it. SmoothShapes treatments range from \$140-\$350 per session.
